## SIP HAPPENS

The Hutcheson Brothers, Jon & Brandon, are award-winning singer-songwriters, musicians, and Nashville country music recording artists from Tennessee.



The brothers recently released their third single Sip Happens (and first music video) on June 30, 2022 on all digital/streaming services and to country radio through CDX Nashville on July 12. The new release follows singles [She Don't Know She's Lonely](#) and their debut #1 independent country single (Nashvegas

Indie Radio Top 30 Countdown) [Drive](#). Those songs, along with their debut EP, were recorded at Beard Music Group, Inc. in Nashville.



Driven by the thrill of performing and writing songs that make a connection with people, the Hutcheson Brothers proudly fly the banner of country music, which reflects their hometown values and southern roots. Natives of Lake County, Tenn., Jon & Brandon come from a musical family. Their

mother, Lorie, is a charting country gospel artist, and their great uncle, Buck Hutcheson, was a 50-plus year guitarist for 'The Memphis Beats, the touring band for the legendary 'Killer' of Rock N Roll, Jerry Lee Lewis. With family serving as their foundation of musical influences, the brothers have also been heavily inspired by artists such as Garth Brooks, Keith Urban, John Mayer, Merle Haggard, Dan+Shay, Bob Seger, fellow Lake County native Carl Perkins, among many others.

#The brothers have performed in various venues and events across the U.S. including the world-renowned Bluebird Café, the NFL Draft, The Josie Music Awards, Today In Nashville, Tennessee Honey Festival, Lakeside of the Smokies, a private screening of the Ken Burns' 'Country Music' documentary – among many others. They have also either opened for or been on the same show bill with legendary country artists such as Shenandoah, Buddy Jewell, Gene Watson, T. Graham Brown, Ronnie McDowell, and Leona Williams. Additionally, the

Hutcheson Brothers have also been featured on Inside Studio G, the weekly Facebook Live and Sirius XM Garth Channel show, with the best-selling recording artist of all time, country music superstar Garth Brooks.

Over the years, the Hutcheson Brothers have been named nominees for various independent music award shows. They are an 18-time Josie Music Awards nominee and a 5-time Tennessee Music Awards nominee. In 2022, the Hutcheson Brothers earned nominations for both the TMAs and JMAs, the latter occurring in Oct. 2022 at The Grand Ole Opry House in Nashville.
